

Willcox Art and Heritage Trail





Twelve train engines placed in the Railroad Avenue Historic District highlight the role of the railroad in the founding and growth of Willcox as well as the community spirit that keeps it strong.

Each of the twelve was designed and painted by community members, organizations and schools and is accompanied by a plaque that highlights Willcox's railroad heritage. The Trail takes you along Railroad Ave, from the original depot building to "The Commercial", the first building built after the railroad arrived.

Willcox Theater and Arts developed The Art and Heritage Trail as a public art project, and the trains were designed and built by local volunteers. The "Union Pacific Community Ties Giving Program" provided major funding.
